BENGALURU 2020

Objective is to make Bengaluru the preferred Metropolis of India which will serve as the gateway of investment and prosperity for Karnataka.

ABIDE TASK FORCE DELIVERABLES:

- Comprehensive Integrated Development plan for entire Bengaluru, wardwise (Plan Bengaluru 2020) with immediate (2008-2009), medium (2008-2012) and long term (2008-2020) objectives and budgeting and financing perspectives as well. Review all various existing plans.

- Budget and Financing Plan for Plan Bengaluru (Finance Bengaluru) that will include increasing Revenues (by increasing per capita revenue of City) and by minimizing dependence on government funds for long term financing (Private Public Partnership, raising of direct funds, Government funding etc).
- Regular Reviewing and overseeing the implementation of the various projects of Plan Bengaluru and the agencies involved.
- Make recommendations on the Bengaluru governance restructuring.
(Govern Bengaluru).Objective is to reduce multiplicity in planning and create a coordinate structure for execution and financing of Plan Bengaluru including the restructuring of Planning. Investment/Financing, Project Execution and Public service Delivery/maintenance of organizational structures of Bengaluru City with a view of ensuring better costs, better services, transparency and citizen involvement. Ensure government accepts recommendations.
- Create a permanent platform for “citizens-government” interaction-Involve Bengaluru)
 - a. Website and News letter (English and Kannada) (bengaluru.gov)
 - b. 6 monthly State of City survey, state of city summit / progress report.

COMPONENTS AND STRUCTURE OF PLAN BENGALURU 2020

Plan Bengaluru will be a ward wise and locality wise plan, modeled along the lines of othe modern, growth city plans.

How will plan Bengaluru be built?

- Plan Bengaluru is a Citywide plan which is a 3 way matrix of wardwise - Immediate/Priority, medium term, long term objectives. The immediate/Priority objectives include tasks / projects that have already been approved in the last ABIDe meeting.
- Immediate short term objectives must be completed and must make impact between now and March 1st 2009.
- Plan Bengaluru 2020 will consist of chapters / solutions for each of the topics in Annexure 1.
- ABIDe TF will break into several working groups of address each of the topics and to develop a plan that is ward wise with immediate / priority, medium term and long term milestones.

- Working groups can induct non ABIDe members into their groups.
- Working groups will present to ABIDe TF their reports at various points during the next 100 days target to have chapter ready to be incorporated into first draft of Plan Bengaluru in Jan 2009.
- Working groups and their members will be published.

OPERATION AND MEETINGS OF ABIDe TASK FORCE

- Kickoff of ABIDe TF 10.09.08
- One meeting per week on Fridays 10 am to 12 Noon – presided by Vice Chairman. There may be more than one meeting a week if found necessary by Vice Chairman / Convener. These meetings could also have field trip to a designated agency or part of Bengaluru. Non-official Members to note and keep this free definitely. Concerned Official members will be informed one week in advance.
- Full meeting of ABIDe TF under Chairmanship of CM to be held monthly on first Friday of the month between 6 pm to 9 pm.

ABIDe TF will break into specific working groups for each of the Plan topics of Plan Bengaluru.

MILESTONES-

- First cut presentation on Plan to CM 10.10.08.
- First 100 days – Feb 1st week 2009 – (This meet will also provide inputs for budget)
- Second 100 days – May 1st week 2009

100 DAY DELIVERABLES –

- All Immediate / Priority Objectives for all plan elements to have been met.
- Plan Bengaluru Draft.
- Status report of other medium and long term objectives.
- Finance Bengaluru Draft ready, inputs for Budget and schedule of Private public Partnerships to be ready for tendering process.
- Govern Bengaluru Draft ready.
